**Elvis Presley: 'Elvis is Back'**

Fresh out of the Army, Elvis recorded this album over just 2 sessions (March 20th & April 2nd). What could have turned out to be a rushed mess of product was a diverse set (blues to ballads to rock n' roll and country) of inspired performances that more than highlighted the King's ability to cover just about any sort of material convincingly. All time classic. Coming early November. Tracks include: 'Reconsider Baby', 'The Girl Of My Best Friend', 'Fever', 'I'll be Home Again'.

**Gil Evans: 'The Individualism Of Gil Evans'**

At last, one might cry, at last these gems are available again after so many years. Strangely enough, connoisseurs of fine sound and music with a difference have been very reserved when it came to expressing their appreciation of the arranger, composer and conductor Gil Evans. Gil's milestones in jazz history (his work with Miles Davis and his melancholy trumpet is now legendary) have become entrenched in our memories thanks to his unusual combination of instruments: waldhorns, tuba, oboe - all played by jazz musicians. Includes 'Hotel Me', 'Flute Song' and 'Las Vegas Tango'. Available now.

**Gene Krupa: 'Drummer Man'**

Bubbling over with jams that are lively and swingin' is Gene Krupa's Drummer Man. For this happy-toned collection, Krupa unites with vocalist Anita O'Day who sings with heart-wrenching feeling and trumpeter Roy Eldridge whose horn delivers with intense clarity and piercing brilliance. "Let Me Off Uptown" is an energetic homage to the infamous NYC neighborhood. "That's What You Think" finds Anita at her best as she sings with scathing sentiment. Krupa gives passionate drum performances on "Wire Brush Stomp" and "Boogie Blues". Available now.

**Neil Young :'Prairie Wind'**

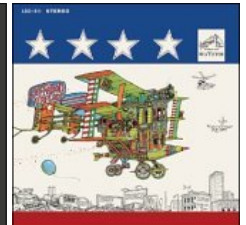
The new Neil Young album should be with us in mid October / early November. Neil has returned to his 'Harvest'/'Harvest Moon' acoustic roots for this outing. The simplicity of the instrumental line up (bass/drums, guitar and the arrangements act as a suitable backdrop for Neil's concerns- the environment, 9/11, family and community. He is one of the few artists capable of combing great music with sophisticated yet heart felt analysis and comment. The set comes with a luxurious 18 page booklet. Side 4 features an extended interview with Neil covering subjects like favourite guitars, band members etc. Tracks include 'Here For You', 'When God Made Me' and 'He Was The King'. Coming soon.

**Chet Baker: 'Chet'**

Chet Baker made many albums throughout his career. Not all of them were thoughtfully conceived or performed to the highest standards but this one surely is. On the session we have Bill Evans, Philly Joe Jones, Kenny Burrell, Pepper Adams and Paul Chambers. Baker blows his melancholic horn over a set of romantic ballads with an assurance and restraint that makes for great listening. If you only need a little Chet in your life, then this is the album to own. Tracks include 'How High The Moon', 'You The Night And The Music' and 'September Song'. Coming soon.

**Memphis Slim: 'USA'**

You can't get more blues than Memphis Slim. His music is honest and direct but sophisticated and loaded with Human warmth and humour.

'Ol' Slim was a big man in every way- his voice polished and passionate but as powerful as a field holler. His piano playing was equally accomplished and capable of extremes. He could boogie woogie like few others, one minute playing a delicate fillgree, the next pounding those keys with righteous authority. To get the best idea of Slim's performing abilities, listen to the opening track, 'Born With The Blues'. That's where you'll learn that the man plays as he feels, and he feels mighty deep. He tells us the story of the blues in a single song, no mean feat. Or if you want finger busting playing get onto the instrumental, 'Red Haired Boogie', it's a monster!

Beautifully recorded as this album is, you have the feeling that Slim could have been performing with his pals in a Chicago Gin House, just having fun. There is a looseness about this set that belies the art and virtuosity that has gone to the performances. Yep, this is a great blues album, alright. Tracks include 'I Believe I'll Settle Down', 'Bad Luck And Troubles' and 'New Key To The Highway'. Slim is joined by Jazz Gilum (who plays a mighty harp) and Arbee Stidum (guitar and vocals). **Jefferson Airplane: 'After Bathing At Baxter's'**

Released in 1967 after the hugely successful, 'Surrealistic Pillow', 'ABAB's' is a wilful attempt by the band to avoid too mainstream. If you want a useful working definition of West Coast Psychedelic a then this ambitious set will a suitable choice for an example. From middle Eastern flavours to delicate acoustic picking, classical- almost prog rock, experiments in guitar feedback and studio trickery, it's all here. Tracks include 'Mather', 'The Ballad of You Me and Pooneil' and 'Wild Thyme'. All analog mastering from the original mastertapes. Mono. Coming soon. Coming soon.

Typically tasty Pablo star studded set from 1980. Along side the headliners, Oscar Peterson, Ray Brown, Joe Pass and Bobby Durham. Tracks include 'Ballad Medley', 'Ballad Medley' and 'Alternate Blues'.

### The Future Sound Of London: 'Amorphous Androgynous Alice In Ultraland'

The Future Sound Of London are a duo who go by the name of Garry Cobain and Brian Dougans. The record they have created is a stream of consciousness electronica experience that takes all sorts of sounds, recorded performance and beats to create a unique musical picture. The pair have used real rhythm tracks and (gaspl) instruments played by real people (tabla, slide guitar, bass, Gospel chorus, Sax and flute etc) and actually written tunes with, yes, real tunes. In many ways this sounds like a rock record from the '60's / '70's - powerful guitars and drums, intricate musical interludes with psychedelic leanings. Of course the music is laden with, but not dependent on, samples, studio trickery and inspired cut and paste musical games but at it shows that Cobain and Dougans are willing to use all at their disposal to make a record that is as captivating as it is varied and thought provoking. Great sleeve art and the pressing is of a high order. Standout tracks 'The Witchfinder', 'Indian Swing' and 'The World Is Full Of Plankton'. **Available now.**

### Lynyrd Skynyrd: 'Poison Whisky'

Licensed from Mercury, this Russian pressing from Lillith Records documents the early days of one of the South's greatest bands, Lynyrd Skynyrd. Here we get to witness the raw energy and craft of a band who even in those days, knew what they were about. Includes 'Gimme Three Steps', 'I Ain't The One' and a nifty take on 'Freebird'. **Coming soon.**

### Jefferson Airplane: 'Takes Off'

The Airplane's first album. Instead of Grace Slick we have Signe Anderson who demonstrates sufficient talent to make one regret that she didn't have more chance to record. The album has a strong blues-folk flavour with less of the eccentricity that would later follow. Strong performances from the band coupled with a brace of great songs makes this unheralded classic a record to treasure. Tracks include 'Tobacco Road', 'Lets Get Together' and 'Come Up The Years'. ### Public Enemy: 'Rebirth Of A Nation'

Few rap groups have had such influence, notoriety and longevity as Public Enemy. This album shows why. Tracks include 'Pump The Music, Pump The Sound', 'They Call Me Flava' and 'Make It Hardcore'. Parental Advisory. **Coming soon.**

### Shirley Collins and the Albion Band: 'No Roses'

Shirley Collins' contribution to British folk music can not be overstated. She is responsible for bringing traditional English music back into the mainstream and her recordings and archival work (Collins always cited her sources) has saved many beautiful songs, often passed down only through oral tradition, from vanishing into obscurity. What Alan Lomax did for the American South (Collins actually accompanied Lomax on a year-long American archiving tour), Collins did for the English countryside, only Collins brought the music into the "now" of the 1960s and 70s, using her own unique voice and modern electric instrumentation.

1971's No Roses is both a seminal and star-studded album in this vein of traditional electrified English folk music. Featuring (then-husband) Ashley Hutchings, Richard Thompson, and Simon Nicol of Fairport Convention fame. **Coming soon.**

### Har Mar Superstar: 'The Handler'

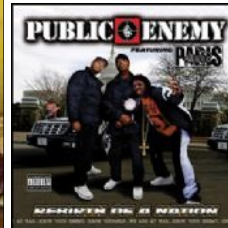
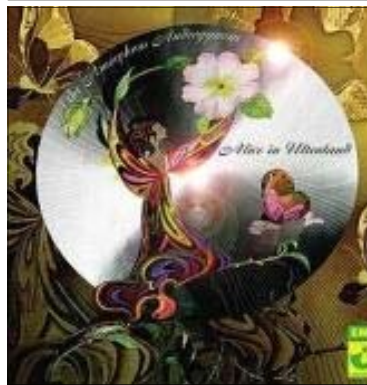
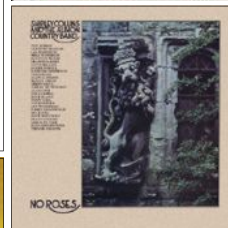

### Taj Mahal: 'Taj Mahal'

Taj Mahal's debut album from 1967. It's mission was to update blues music for a modern rock audience without losing its feeling or authenticity. With a band that included guitarists Ry Cooder and Jessie Ed Davis, Taj had the perfect platform for his warm friendly voice and his more than servicable slide and harp playing. Taj has excellent taste in material and his arrangements have sufficient variety and colour to lift this disc way beyond the normal blues-rock bluster. This album has bags of personality and drive not to mention great songs and sympathetic production. If you like folk blues with a beat and smile on its face then this set needs to be in your collection. Do we say 'recommended' - of course we do! Essential. Tracks include 'Dust My Broom', 'Leaving Trunk' and 'Statesboro Blues'. Coming November. **Coming soon.**
